Cradle to Crayons Learning Center is a privately owned childcare center located in Golden, Colorado. The center is conveniently located inside Heritage Square. We are a State Licensed facility, and care for children ages 6 weeks to 7 years old. We have 5 classrooms to ensure that your child is engaged in age appropriate activities with children of the same age group.

Hours of Operation

Our hours of operation are 7am to 6pm, Monday through Friday. The center is open twelve months a year except for the following days: New Years' Eve, New Years' Day, Memorial Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, and Christmas Day. If one of these major holidays falls on a weekend, the day the center will be closed will correspond with the day the majority of our families have off.

Our staff recognizes that children are unique and individual in their development. We are committed to showing respect to each child through a warm, encouraging, and caring attitude.

Our program is individualized to meet the needs of children as they move through the center. The schedule allows for independent play, group play, social interactions, activity exploration, outside play, and movement. Our staff is educated and experienced in taking care of children and the developmental process.

It is our goal to help the children develop a positive self esteem, a sense of trust and respect for others. We want to facilitate this by providing quality care, a foundation for future learning, and a quality experience while at Cradle to Crayons.

Our Staff

Management

Our Director and Assistant director are dedicated to creating and maintaining an environment that you feel good about bringing your child to each day. They both spend time in all of the classrooms regularly to ensure they are as involved with each child development as possible. Courtney Parry is the Owner and Director of Cradle to Crayons. She has been with us for 3 years. Courtney has her Bachelor's Degree in Behavioral Science and Early Childhood Education for Metro State College and her Large Childcare Center Director's License from Red Rock Community College. Courtney started with Cradle to Crayons in the Infant Center; she has since become the director and recently purchased the center from the previous owner. Courtney has a three year old son who attends Cradle to Crayons as well.

Tara DeMarco, our Assistant director has been at Cradle to Crayons for 5 years. She has her Large Childcare Center Director License from Red Rocks Community College. Tara started with us as a teacher in our Toddler Room; she has since worked in all 5 classrooms. Tara has a 4 and 6 year old girls, both who attend Cradle to Crayons.

We hire only qualified, experienced and caring individuals to care for your children. A majority of our staff have been with Cradle to Crayons for many years. All of our teachers are experienced with young children; most have children of their own. They are all CRP and First Aide certified, as well as receive ongoing training each year in the growth and development of young children.

Programs

Infants

Our infant center cares for children 6 weeks to approximately 12 months old. We are licensed for 10 children and the ratio is 1 caregiver for 5 children. Development at this age can vary from month to month. We try to follow whatever schedule works best at home. Caregivers spend a lot of time reading, singing, working on tummy time, practicing sitting up, etc. We know that each child is a unique individual and will reach milestones in his own time. Each child is held while being fed, and given plenty of personal attention and love throughout the day. Our infant center offers a home like, comfortable environment for you and your child.

Wobblers and Toddlers

Our Wobbler Room cares for children 12 to 24 months. We are licensed for 10 children and the ratio is 1 caregiver for 5 children. Little ones at this stage are working on becoming steady on their feet while exploring their world. Some structure and plenty of routine is introduced to this class. Wobblers have a daily circle time in which they go over animals, animal noises, naming and identifying body parts, sing songs, reading, etc. Each child is given the personal attention and care they need, as well as lots of hugs!!

Our Toddler Room cares for children 24 to 30 months. We are licensed for 10 Toddlers and the ratio is 1 teacher for 5 children. Teachers plan activities around a theme based curriculum. Daily activities help foster your child's cognitive, language, motor, and social skills. Each child is given a chance to explore and learn through their own means. We offer each child one on one attention as well as group interactions to stimulate development.

Weather permitting, the Wobblers and Toddlers spend an hour outside on our playground each day.

Preschool 1 and 2

Our Preschool 1 cares for children 2 ½ to 3 ½ years old. We are licensed for 15 children and the ratio is 1 caregiver for 8 children. The teachers plan weekly lesson planned based on a monthly theme. Our theme based curriculum emphasizes language development to help children communicate their ideas. Group activities are planned to foster their social, cognitive, language, and motor skills. This room introduces a preschool program, with a daily group time including learning shapes and colors, and well as introducing letters and numbers. This introduction to preschool excites the children as well as parents. The growth you will see in your child at this age is amazing.

Our Preschool 2 cares for children 3 ½ to 7 years old. We are licensed for 30 children and the ratio is 1 caregiver to 10 children. The teachers plan a weekly lesson plan based on a monthly theme. Our theme based curriculum emphasizes pre-kindergarten readiness, including prewriting skills, early math skills, letter recognition. We focus introducing these basic skills through a play environment, where children are encouraged to explore and learn in a manner that will benefit them the most.
